FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WITH THE BOROUGH OF
EAST NEWARK

WHEREAS: Red Bull Park requires the use of off-duty Town of Harrison ("Harrison") police officers to provide security at events, with Red Bull paying the current extra-duty rate established by the Town; and

WHEREAS: Due to vacation schedules and other manpower issues, there may not be enough off-duty Harrison police officers for any given Red Bull Park event; and

WHEREAS: In the event of a shortage, the Harrison Police Department desires to use off-duty East Newark police officers, with Red Bull paying them the same rate as Harrison police officers; and

WHEREAS: An agreement for Law Enforcement Services ("Agreement"), is required to set forth the duties and responsibilities of the parties; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor and Council are desirous to enter into such an Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Harrison, Hudson County, New Jersey, as follows:

THAT: Chief of Police Derek J. Kearns is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement for Law Enforcement Services, and to take all other steps necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.

WHEREAS: In the 2010-2011 grant cycle, priority funding will be giving to county projects to perform municipal inventories, needs assessments and strategic plans for all of their municipalities; and

WHEREAS: The Town of Harrison desires to collaborate with the County of Hudson in the performance of the PARIS Grant program; and

WHEREAS: The Town of Harrison is acknowledging that its funding will be leveraged with County of Hudson; and

WHEREAS: The Town of Harrison is acknowledging that the County of Hudson would be both the lead agency and the applicant for such a proposal.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1224 CONCERNING
CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF HARRISON, COUNTY OF
HUDSON AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Harrison, County of Hudson, and State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION 1: There is hereby established within the Town of Harrison the permanent civil service position of Traffic Control Officer, effective immediately, with the salaries as set forth below.

<u>TITLE</u>	<u>MINIMUM SALARY</u>	<u>2010 MAXIMUM SALARY</u>	<u>2011 MAXIMUM SALARY</u>
Traffic Control Officer, part-time	\$10/hour	\$25/hour	\$25/hour

SECTION 2: No Traffic Control Officer shall receive any vacation days, holidays, sick time, or any other type of leave. Further, no Traffic Control Officer shall receive medical or any other type of benefits.

SECTION 3: Any existing ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions herein are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage according to law.
